Gage: STAFF TYPE. ATTACHED TO DOWNSTREAM END OF RIGHT PIER OF JEFFERSON BARRACKS BRIDGE. OWNED, OPERATED AND MAINTAINED BY ST. LOUIS DISTRICT, CORPS OF ENGINEERS.
